DERBY CAR RULES

Each car is inspected at weigh-in by inspection committee:

Pinewood Derby Car Dimensions

- 1. The overall length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
- 2. The overall width of the car shall not exceed 3 inches.
- 3. The car must use the standard Lego Derby wheels and axles

Derby Car Weight

- 1. The car weight shall not exceed 5.0 ounces.
- 2. The official race scale that is used at car check-in shall be considered final.

Wheels and Axles

- 1. The wheels may not be cut, drilled, or rounded. You may remove the seams and imperfections from wheels.
- 2. The Axles may be polished and or lubricated with lead graphite only.
- 3. The Axles may not be altered.

Car Modifications Not Allowed

- 1. Wheel bearings, washers or bushings are prohibited.
- 2. The car must not ride on any type type of springs.
- 3. No starting devices. The car must be freewheeling.
- 4. No loose material of any kind, such as lead shot may be used.

Other Derby Race Rules

- 1. Once a car passes inspection and is entered into the race, only race committee members or the racer can touch it.
- 2. If a car loses a piece or is otherwise damaged, the racer

shall have 5 minutes to make a repair. Must be reweighed

- 3. Each car must pass inspection by the inspection committee.
- 4. The inspection committee has the responsibility to disqualify those cars that do not meet these specifications and has final say.
- 5. The cars will be built on Wednesday March 10 and will be raced on Wednesday March 17.
